

## 2000 seats to be increased in IIM

Country's top most management institutes IIM soon going to increase the number of seats. More students are going to get the opportunity to study in IIM. It is estimated that 2000 seats will be increased. The running IIMs have a good number of seats rather than the newly established ones. So, 300-400 seats will be increased in older IIMs whereas 80-120 seats are running in the new ones.

According to Human Resource and Development

(HRD), seats will be increased from the next session. All IIMs have been asked for the action plan to increase the seats. One of the chief officer of the ministry told that all the 20 IIMs have been instructed for this. In a meeting with the central minister Prakash Jawdekar in Shillong, IIM has given assurity to double the seats. Presently there are nearly 10 thousand seats total in all the IIMs, which has to be done 20 thousand. For this proper planning has

to be done and implemented. Starting is done with the increment of 2000 seats.

There is no facility of MBA in IIM, hence they provide Post Graduate Diploma Program (PGDP). The demand of this two year course is very high in our country and outside country too. However there are five thousand seats for this. Government has also planned to increase the number of PGDP seats. Hopefully, more students will be able to gain the PGDP.

### MBA will be done after the making of Law

As soon as the IIM bill will be passed in the Parliament, law will be made for IIM. With this, IIM will be having the right to give degree also. After this, IIM may also start MBA degree. At present, the bill has been sent to the ministry. Central government has told that however the older IIMs don't depend upon Central for economical resources, but to increase the seats if help is needed then centre will help it.

## NEET to be conducted in eight languages for admission in MBBS

Central ministry of health has started preparation for the NEET-2 examinations. This time examination will be conducted in other six local languages too other than English and Hindi. Now there are total eight languages for appear-

ing in NEET examinations. Along with Karnataka and Kerala many other states have demanded for this. This year only some selected languages will be given

permission as the particular states had demanded for this earlier. As per the instructions of Supreme Court, for the entrance in medical, single exam of NEET started from last year. Later, states were allowed for own tests. Now the admission will depend on the NEET examinations.

According to the sources of Central ministry of health, six local languages have been permitted to take NEET-2 tests. In which Tamil, Gujarati, Bengali, Marathi, Assamese language is included. Prior to this decision, ministry had previously consulted with all states. Then only some states had demanded for this. But now two more states want to be in the list. However, ministry is not in the favor to add any more states. For this, permission from Supreme Court and CBSE is required. Other states have to wait for this whole exercise.

## 9.75 Lakh seats of Engineering vacant

One of the most selected career option engineering is running with 9 lakh vacant seats. This is the estimated vacancy because last year 8.75 lakh seats remained empty. Along with the Southern states, UP too is suffering with this situation. Many

seats are left unfulfilled. As per All Indian Council for technical education (AICTE), during 2015-16, 16.94 lakh engineering seats were sanctioned for total number of 3,073 colleges. Among which only 8.19 lakh seats got fulfilled and more than this 8.75 lakh seats remained vacant.

Economy is also responsible for vacant seats

Chairman of engineering council Dr. Udes Kohli says that according to our Indian population, the number of engineering seat is accurate. But, the actual problem is the slow growth of our economy. Due to which, employment opportunities are less for the engineers. And the seats are going vacant. One more important thing is poor quality of education is also responsible for vacant seats due to which students don't choose engineering as their option.

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## Main exams of RRB to be conducted online

course from this college. But, the college management issued her certificate after a one month delay. Even before, according to academic rules college management neglected to provide compulsory services to the student. Monica had filed a case on this too, whose decision came some days ago in favour of Monica. Court has fined 5000 pound for careless service and 1377 pound for delay in issuing her certificate. Blame on the college

Monica Maldrick has accused the college for spoiling her whole one year. She tells that due to the delay of certificate she was not able to take admission in any other course. And along with the delay college did not provide her basic services too. After hearing the case, court found the college guilty. Court verdicts that if any student suffers due to the negligence of the college, then the college will also be liable to punishment.

### What qualities do the job of the pilot requires?

Pilot is a profession of discipline, patience, responsibility, punctuality, commitment and dedication. The job requires a lot of hard work, stamina, alertness of mind, adaptability to follow difficult time schedules, ability to think in crisis, good team spirit etc. Apart from possessing these qualities, the persons willing to take up this as profession, should be calm, pleasant, compassionate, understanding, technically sound and good spatial orientation.

### What are the different types of pilot license?

There are 3 types of pilot license:

#### Student Pilot License

SPL is a prerequisite for flying is obtaining Private Pilot's License and Commercial Pilot's License. No flight experience is required to obtain SPL. The candidate must be at least 16 years old at the time of issue of his/her student Pilot's License with a minimum qualification of 10th standard. This can be obtained from any flying club in India after a test of air regulations, aviation meteorology, air navigation and technical aspect. First, candidates have to appear in an oral examination and they have also to go through a medical test. After medical clearance, candidates have to clear a theory paper. Government sponsored flying club in every State



conducts this examination, which is stipulated by the DGCA (Directorate General of Civil Aviation).

#### Private Pilot License:

The PPL training course is offered to the person who wants to become a Licensed Pilot in preparation for an advanced training program for business transportation or wants to experience the unlimited freedom and the romance of flying. This course offers flight training right from ab-initio level to Private Pilot's License. The 3 to 10 months of course depending on the 8 institute enrolled, gives you 40 hours of flying time. On Completion of this program, a person becomes Pilot to fly an aircraft carrying passengers or cargo but not for hire, reward or remuneration. This is for hobby flying.

The qualification of this license authorizes a pilot to non-commercially fly aircrafts as endorsed on the license. Additionally, PPL licensee can also fly at night with night and instru-

ment ratings. A candidate has to pass the examination conducted by DGCA in ground subjects and have a minimum of 40 to 60 flying hours to get this license depending on the institute enrolled. Night Rating entitles the holder of the license to carry passengers at night. Conditions for the issue of this rating are detailed below:-

- He must have completed not less than fifty hours of flight time as pilot in command and as sole manipulator of the controls including not less than five hours by night, which must include a minimum of five take-offs and five landings carried out within the preceding six months of the date of application;
- He must have completed a dual cross-country flight by night of at least one hundred nautical miles before he can be permitted to undertake sole cross-country flights by night.
- He must have completed not less than five hours of dual instructions in instrument flying which may include not more than two and a half hours on an approved synthetic flight trainer

#### Commercial Pilot License:

The commercial license allows you to work as a professional pilot and be remunerated for flying. With a commercial license you will be eligible for employment with any commercial operation such as charter flying, contract flying, corporate flying, survey flying, agricultural flying, flight instruction and airline flying.

Commercial pilot is a highly trained person who flies an aircraft to facilitate the movement of people, mail or goods, from one destination to another. Pilot's office is the cockpit which contains all controls, instruments, electronic communication and navigation instruments which are

necessary to operate the aircraft. Aircraft of a cockpit is meant for pilot, co-pilots and other crew members. Pilots and Co-pilots, generally sit in this compartment. The most experienced pilot, also known as captain, usually holds the flying commands and supervises all other crew members.

#### Pre-requisites:

- i. The age bracket for getting a CPL is between 18 years and 30 years and to have taken Physics and Mathematics at 10+2 with at least 50% to 55%
- ii. You need a student pilot license first and fly a minimum of 200 hours of flying to get this license. This has to be a combination of solo flying, cross-country flying, instrument flying (which means you rely only on the plane's instruments for flying without looking at the horizon or external assistance), and 5 hours of flying in the night.
- iii. A class 1 medical certificate from approved organisations and proficient in English language is compulsory. The curriculum will include theory tests in Air Regulations, Aviation Meteorology, Air Navigation, Technical and Planning etc.
- iv. Clear the RTR (Radio Telephone Restricted to Aeromobile) exam conducted by the WIRELESS PLANNING & COORDINATION (WPC) Wing of the Ministry of Communications, GOI
- v. Pass Flying Skills Test
- vi. Pass the written exams of the DGCA
- vii. Be in possession of Indi-

an FRTOL (Flight Radio Telephone Operators License)

#### Airline Transport Pilot's License:

The above mentioned licenses can only allow you to fly as a co-pilot. If you want to take over as captain, you need the Airline Transport Pilot's License, which is the highest aviation license available. Along with clearing written papers, you also need to clock a total of 1,500 flying hours and take medical tests.

#### What are the costs of flying hours?

The average cost of an hour flying range from Rs.8000 per hour and above. The cost varies with the complications of engines and aircraft. The cost is hefty more for helicopters.

After the gradation work of these colleges, 500 seats for MBBS and 18 seats for PG will be increased.

He also told that students will get admission in and BTech in Information Technology & Social Science on the ranking basis of JEE-MAINS and marks achieved in class twelve. Students scored pass marks in twelfth of any stream can apply for this course. 100 seats will be made available in the new course.

The number of Indian students has decreased since last five years. Students should be kept different from the people coming for work purpose. Post-study visa of two years should be applied once again which was taken back in the year 2012.
